

Archivology is an independent, academic, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary science.

The Departments of Archival Science (all three bologna levels) at Alma Mater Europaea, managed by assoc. prof. Peter Pavel Klasinc (Head of Departments of Archival Science), approached the organization of the 1st International Symposium of students of the independent study program of archival sciences. The Student Symposium (free of charge) took place at ZOOM channel at 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022. At our premiere Symposium we hosted 21 presenters from 10 countries and total of approximately 75 listeners. The purpose of this event was that students of independent program of archival studies present their research topic to international colleagues. There were 16 phd students, 5 bachelor degree students and 1 master's degree student who presented their body of research in archival field. We are really impressed with diversity of research topics, innovative approaches to research and interesting presentations of their current findings. The Student Symposium validate the definition that Archiviology indeed is an independent, academic, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary science.

These kind of Student Symposiums are new concept at Archival Science educational field. We are planning to organize Archival Student Symposium regularly, because we had positive feedback from professors and also from students and we believe they are positive step towards development of Archiviology.
